

Don't Have Cycling Gear? Do Not Fear, Begamo is Here!

Guests and Staff alike may borrow the two foldable *Dahon* bicycles at Bergamo to ride around the Mount Saint John Campus and paved trails nearby. Please note - No cycling is permitted on the nature preserve trails of Mount Saint John. The bikes fold up and will fit easily in a car trunk so do not need a car mounted bicycle rack. Additionally Bergamo offers cycling gear for the bikes, including locks, lights, racks and helmets. Inquire about use at the front desk.

We are actively planning the first *Bergamo Bike to Work Day* on May 15, 2020. Employees will be allowed more casual dress code in honor of BTWD and additionally employees will be allowed flexible scheduling in honor of BTWD. Any Bergamo employees who bike to work during the month of May will be entered in a drawing for one of the unique rustic Ohio Star Quilts Block Patterns or a Bike Antlers Trophy Mount.

Bergamo - A Cycling Friendly Business?

Bergamo offers parking, water and restroom access to cyclists. We simply ask cyclists to check in at the front desk. The driveways of the Mount Saint John are accessible to cycling guests and visitors to the property. All guests who ride to Bergamo will be entered in an annual drawing for an Ohio Star Quilt Block Pattern or a Bike Antler Trophy Mount. Cyclists are reminded that speeds are restricted to the same speed limits for all other vehicles - no more than 15 mph on the black top paved surfaces. There is no cycling permitted on the sidewalks or natural trails on the property.

National Bike Summit
