Guest groups at the Bergamo Center may not realize that as a Sponsored Ministry of the Marianists the Center rents the space



from the Marianists. Bergamo and the Marianists of Mount Saint John regularly collaborate on facility improvements and we have a major one this summer.

The Marianist Province and our Mount Saint John Facilities Manager have authorized a project to replace the mansard roof around the building. The work is slated to begin on June 15 and extend through August 15. The work will be conducted from 6am to 4pm and may include some weekends. We are expecting noise, equipment and workers around the building as they abate the old cement shingles and prepare for replacing with the new asphalt shingles.

For some large groups that fill the whole center we have requested that no work be done during those times. However there may be scaffolding, cranes and supplies located around the building and alternate entrances to the building that may alter normal patterns around the building.

In addition, the second phase of window replacement in Unit 2 of the bedrooms will take place the second week of August. Guest groups have been notified in advance. Patience and understanding are appreciated through this work phase.
