Aggiornamento - Bergamo Jubilee

As we celebrated the Bergamo 50th anniversary it was a wonderful time to review the history of the center from its beginnings in 1967 as the *John XXIII Center for Christian Renewal*. In those 50 years since 1967 Bergamo has been the host of an estimated one half million guests.



In our year of celebration we served an estimated 2,154 complimentary chocolate chip cookies. In just the past year Bergamo was host to 7,889 guests, served 32,979 meals and lodged guests for a total of 7,312 nights.

Once again we thank the generous sponsors of our Jubilee Celebration of 2017: Miller Valentine, Houser Asphalt & Concrete, and Enterprise Roofing & Sheet Metal Company.

One of the themes that came up often in the early history of Bergamo to inspire the move to build a new Retreat Center serving the Dayton area was the word Aggiornamento, an Italian word pronounced: [addzorna' mento], meaning, "A bringing up to date." It was one of the key words used by John XXIII leading up to the Second Vatican Council and was mentioned both by bishops and clergy attending the sessions. It was used to mean throwing open the doors of the Church in a desire to update dialogue with the outside world.

As we look forward to the next 50 years of the Bergamo Center we again see the need for aggiornamento, to update the Bergamo Center to meet the needs of a new time, new technologies and new forms of evangelization. Steps have been taken to refresh the Bergamo Center facilities and studies are in process for more to come. Our newly formed mission integration plan calls for deeper and richer service to our guests. May the spirit of aggiornamento be with us. Thank you for your patience and continued support.
